

Explore your affordability options for Jascayd® (nerandomilast) tablets

If your doctor has prescribed JASCAYD and you need help paying for it, there are resources that may be able to help you.

You can ask your CareConnect4Me™ team **about potential financial support options listed below.**

If you use commercial health insurance, you may be eligible for the JASCAYD Commercial Copay Program



If you have commercial insurance, you will have the opportunity to enroll into the JASCAYD copay program. The Specialty Pharmacy will enroll you into the program and provide a status on your eligibility.

- You may receive JASCAYD for as little as \$0 per month. There is no card to carry or worry about

- If you are covered by any form of government-funded healthcare program (Medicare, Medicaid, Tricare, VA, etc), you are not eligible for the program. Also, if you are paying cash, you will not be eligible

Medicare Prescription Payment Plan (M3P)



The M3P is a no-cost budgeting tool that helps you manage your medication costs with fixed monthly payments throughout the plan year. If you have a Medicare drug plan or Medicare Advantage plan that includes drug coverage, enrolling is simple and flexible, allowing you to opt in at any time each year.

If you use government-funded healthcare programs, such as Medicare or Medicaid, or need supplemental assistance paying for JASCAYD, other financial assistance resources may be available



If you are enrolled in a government healthcare prescription drug program, do not have insurance, or have private insurance that does not cover JASCAYD, financial assistance from independent foundations may be available. These independent foundations typically require separate applications, have financial eligibility guidelines, and require financial documentation, such as copies of your latest tax return.

Filling your Jascayd[®] (nerandomilast) tablets prescription

JASCAYD is available only through a Specialty Pharmacy, which is different from your neighborhood pharmacy. Specialty Pharmacies focus on medicines for conditions not typically handled in a retail pharmacy setting and have experience with and understanding of your condition.

Steps to getting your prescription from the Specialty Pharmacy

STEP 1



Prescription is sent to the Specialty Pharmacy by your physician



STEP 2



Doctor's office works to secure the prior authorization from your insurance company



STEP 3



Once prior authorization is approved, the Specialty Pharmacy will call you

Your pharmacy benefits may change from time to time, so make note of your current healthcare team's phone numbers and write down any updates.

Things to Know



When the Specialty Pharmacy calls, the number may come up as **"blocked"** or **"unknown."** If you don't answer, they will leave a general message **"about your prescription."**
