Jascayd® (nerandomilast) tablets is a medicine that is carried only by certain Specialty Pharmacies. Sometimes, it may take extra time to process your insurance and receive your medicine. This guide explains what to expect, where to find support, and how your prescription is filled.

Getting your prescription filled

Once your doctor decides Jascayd® (nerandomilast) tablets is right for you:

You and your doctor complete the Prescription and Patient Support Program Enrollment Form.

You provide:

- Your contact, insurance, and prescription benefit information
- Consent(s) for the CareConnect4Me™ support program and other offerings

Your doctor:

- Completes the prescription page
- Selects an approved Specialty Pharmacy to fill your prescription

There are multiple ways to provide your consent (Patient Authorization).

Your signature is required to enroll in the CARECONNECT4ME Program.

- Complete the e-signature in the CoverMyMeds® electronic enrollment portal while in your doctor's office
- Receive an email from patient_services@covermymeds.com stating that "your action is requested" where you can complete an e-signature
- Receive a text from CoverMyMeds from 30402, which will state "Your doctor signed you up to opt into texts about your Rx."
- Sign at your doctor's office on the paper Enrollment Form
 - Complete the required information, including the Patient Consent Checkbox, signature, and date sections
- Sign via patient self-enrollment on www.jascayd.com

If your doctor does not sign you up for CARECONNECT4ME, you can self-enroll in the program.

Step 1:

On www.jascayd.com, select a condition. Then click **Find Support**.



Step 2:

Select **ENGLISH** or **ESPAÑOL**. You will be asked if you want to exit the JASCAYD website; select **CONTINUE**

If you or someone you care for have been prescribed JASCAYD, now is the time to enroll in CARECONNECT4ME. CARECONNECT4ME is a comprehensive support program that provides personalized, compassionate care right from the start of treatment with JASCAYD.

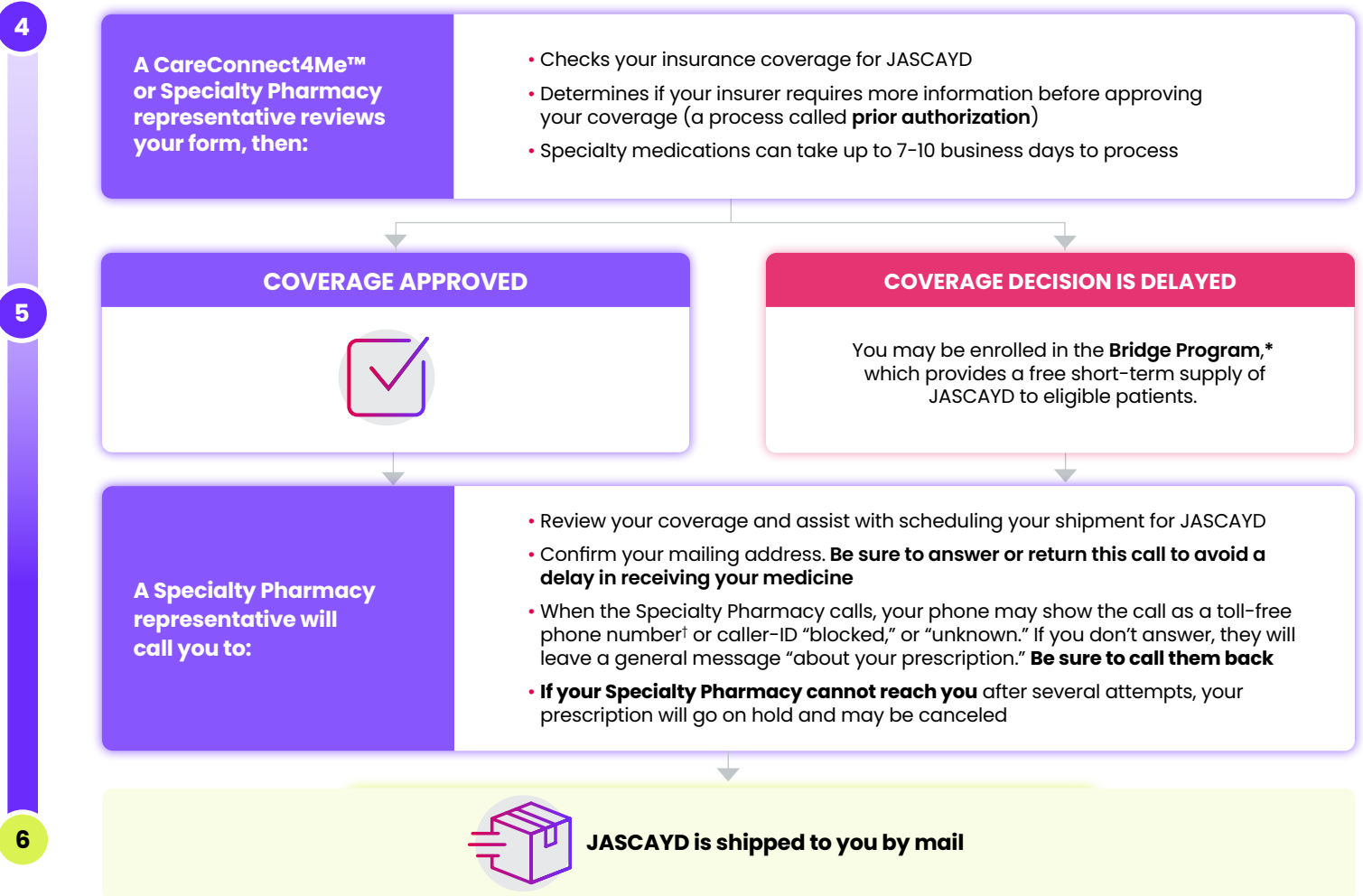

If you use commercial health insurance, you may be eligible for the JASCAYD Commercial Copay Program

If you have commercial insurance, you will have the opportunity to enroll in the JASCAYD copay program. The Specialty Pharmacy will enroll you in the program and provide a status on your eligibility.

- You may receive JASCAYD for as little as \$0 per month. There is no card to carry or worry about
